



Eligibility Checklist

In order to be eligible for the program the applicant **MUST:** (check box for yes)

- Be ready, willing, and able to attend 10-week in classroom training followed by at minimum part time employment (training is Monday – Friday 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM).
- Not have any upcoming legal or medical appointments that would conflict with the training times of the program.
- Not be attending schooling, another program, or registered with another agency.
- Not on parole from a federal institution or on probation during the full 22 weeks.
- Have been twelve months clean from any substance use issues and be medically cleared or have proof of completion from a recovery centre.
- Not be currently pregnant.
- Have a minimum Level 5 for speaking, reading and writing English according to the Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB).
- Have stable living accommodations and environment and be up to date on rent/utilities.
- Have reliable transportation (access to transit, own vehicle).
- Have reliable childcare and back up childcare in place during class time.
- Have a valid photo ID
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have a barrier to employment, permanent injury, disability, mental health barrier
